



University Medicine Greifswald, constituting a component entity of the University of Greifswald with legal capacity, is seeking to fill the positions of

two W3-professorships (without directorship) for translational and experimental oncology with a focus on the "interaction of tumor and immune system in malignant diseases" (m/f/d)

The professorships shall be independent, allocated to the newly established Comprehensive Cancer Center Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, and are intended to strengthen research in the field of translational oncology in Greifswald.

Applicants must be internationally recognized scientists from suitable specialist fields (e.g. human medicine, biology or other life sciences) with expertise in the field of tumor biology or experimental oncology. In the context of the interaction of tumor and immune system, applicants' subject areas should include, among others, disturbances of cellular and/or tissue homeostasis, mechanisms of cell competition between tumor and immune cells, and/or cellular and humoral immune responses in malignant diseases and their therapeutic usability.

University Medicine Greifswald both promotes and expects family-friendly leadership.

In accordance with Section 58 of the *Landeshochschulgesetz* (State Higher Education Law) Mecklenburg-Vorpommern (LHG-MV), applicants shall – beyond meeting the general provisions pertaining to public sector employment - fulfill the following **requirements**: a university degree, extensive teaching experience, PhD and habilitation or proof of equivalent scientific accomplishments in the field of tumor biology or experimental oncology. Outstanding research achievements and acquisitions of third-party research funding as well as experience in designing and conducting innovative translational research projects and the supervision of graduate theses are also expected.

The positions shall be filled in accordance with Section 61 LHG-M-V.

The positions are open to all applicants, irrespective of gender. University Medicine Greifswald would like to increase the proportion of women in areas in which they are underrepresented and thus applications from women are particularly welcome and will be treated with priority if they have the same qualifications and as long as there are no clear reasons which make a fellow applicant more suitable. Severely disabled applicants with the same professional and personal qualifications will be considered with preference.

Arising application costs shall not be reimbursed by University Medicine Greifswald.

Applications must include a Curriculum Vitae (CV) detailing the applicant's academic career, a directory of scholarly publications and courses taught, the impact factors of the previous five years, details of externally raised funds, academic certificates, proof of appointments, nominations and teaching experience as well as five select original publications.
